GENEROSITY

We are approaching the end of our fiscal year. We are grateful for your generosity in 2018. It has empowered this community of faith to proclaim God's love, mercy, peace, and justice.

We've received several questions this week about 2018-2019 giving. In an effort to give you the information you need to give generously at the end of 2018 and to plan for 2019, we've detailed answers to the most frequently asked questions.

Have I completed my pledge for 2018?

We eagerly await the arrival of approximately \$33,000 in outstanding pledges. Vicki Mann, Church Administrator, recently mailed giving statements to all active households. That statement details how much your household has given so far in 2018. It also outlines how much, if any, remains to be completed on your 2018 pledge. If you are unable to locate the giving statement in the stack of Christmas greeting cards, please call Vicki Mann, and she'll give you your household information over the phone. How can I complete the giving pledge I made for 2018 or make an additional year-end gift?

Each year, we rely on additional year end gifts to fulfill our budget. Our Financial Stewardship Committee would be delighted to see \$13,000 in additional gifts between now and December 31. If you would like to pay the remaining amount of your 2018 pledge or make an additional year-end gift, you can do it one of three ways:

- Write a check and mail it. The letter needs to be postmarked by Monday, December 31.
- Write a check and drop it off at Holy Trinity. The church office is open from 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and from 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. on Fridays. The office is closed on Christmas Day. All checks received in worship on Sunday, December 30, will also be counted as a 2018 donation.
- Pay the remainder of your pledge or make an additional gift online. *From a bank account:* If you simply wish to make a one-time year-end donation, you do not need to create a profile. Go to htlcmpls.org, click on the *Give Online* button, enter the amount you wish to contribute to the general fund, and click continue to be directed to a page where you can enter your bank information. Gifts received online between now and midnight on December 31 will be counted as 2018 donations. *From a credit card or debit card:* Go to htlcmpls.org/donate. All major credit cards and debit cards are accepted.

I cannot complete my 2018 pledge because my life circumstances have changed. Now what?

We understand that life changes, sometimes without much forewarning. If you find that you're unable to fulfill your pledge for 2018, don't worry. Simply let us know that your plans have changed. Our first priority is supporting you and caring for you in whatever life circumstances you find yourself!

I would like to pledge for 2019. How can I do that?

We have received 131 financial commitments for 2019! If you have not yet pledged for 2019, please call us and inform us of your plans. We would love to receive your commitments by January 4.
